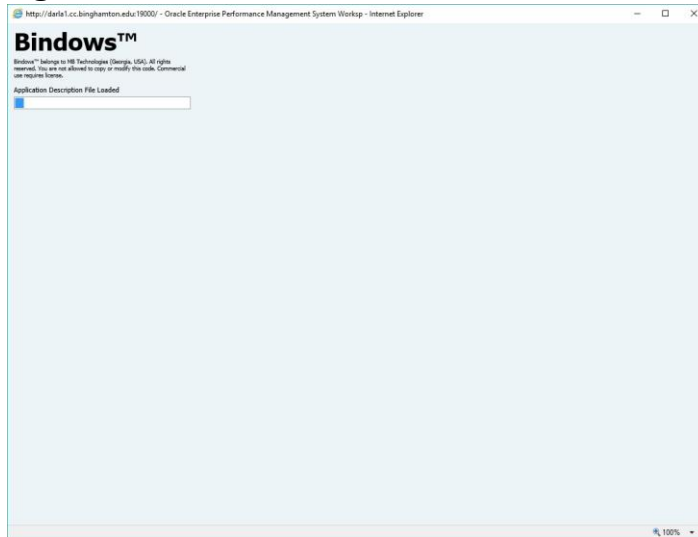


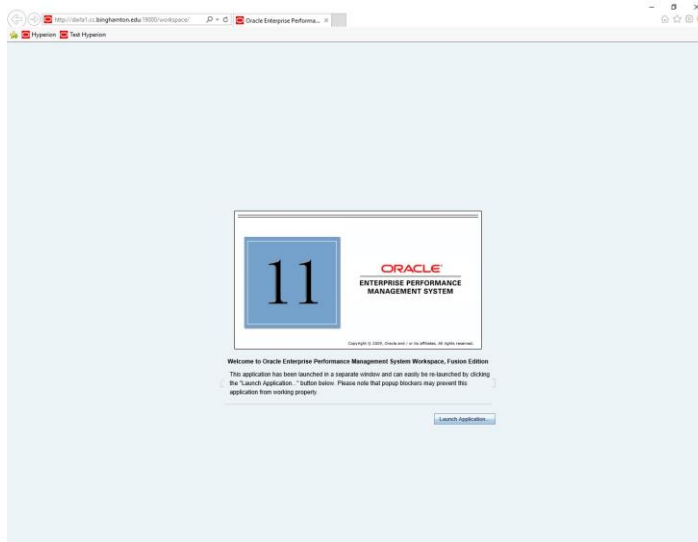


When accessing the Hyperion Login screen, you may encounter the **Bindows error**. The following steps will help to correct this...

First, close the Bindows pop-up window, by clicking the 'X' in the upper right-hand corner

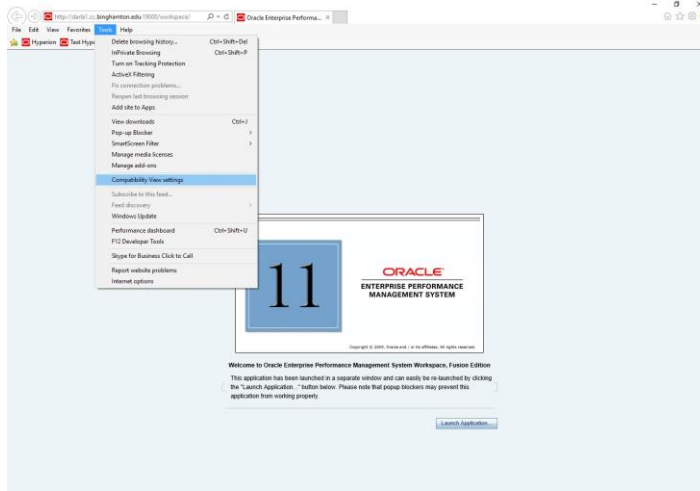


You should now have the launch page still open

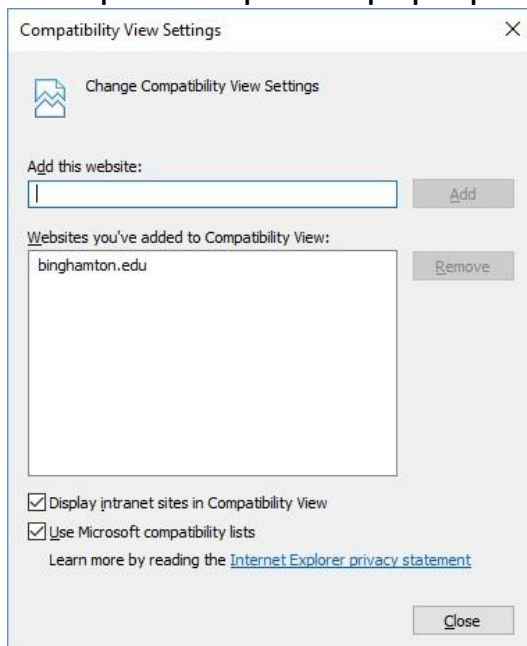


Next, click on 'Tools' in the menu Bar

*NOTE: if the menu bar is not visible, please refer to the last page for instructions on how to view it



Within the drop down menu, select 'Compatibility View Settings' this will open a separate pop-up box



In the 'Add this webpage:' box, type; binghamton.edu (note: it may already be entered)

Click 'Add'

Both check boxes should be checked.....Click 'Close'

Upon closing the window, the Hyperion Login page should open...



Adding Menu Bar:

To make the menu bar visible, you will need to right click in the open space to the right of the open tab
