Doctoral students who have been admitted to candidacy are eligible to apply for the Rosa Colecchio Travel Award for Dissertation Research Enhancement, which is funded through an endowment established by the family of Rosa Romano Colecchio with the Binghamton University Foundation. The travel award must enhance the dissertation in a way that would not be accomplished otherwise. Supported activities may include travel for research dependent upon library materials not obtainable through regular channels, archival materials, other original source materials, techniques, equipment, and methodologies not available on this campus, or opportunities to carry out extraordinary field research. This program cannot be used for travel to a professional meeting. The maximum award size is \$800.
