Because resources and services frequently change, it is not an exhaustive list, but serves as an example of some of the types of services and resources available at the time this list was updated. If you click on a link or identify a resource that is no longer accessible or has changed, please feel free to email us at icd@binghamton.edu so we can make updates.

Importantly, this list does not serve as an endorsement of service providers nor does it indicate a lack of endorsement of providers not on this list. In other words, we are not able to vouch for the quality of care you might receive or your satisfaction with any of the available resources from programs that we do not supervise ourselves. The information contained in this guide is simply a compilation of possible useful resources to cut down on family effort in searching for help when they need it most. We hope this guide will make it easier for each parent and family to make independent decisions about what best meets their family's needs and to reduce stressors in finding resources in South Central NY and neighboring areas.

To support our families, we have organized the guide by categories so that it is easier to search by a topic that might relate to your current need rather than a list of general resources. This means that you may see agencies listed under multiple categories in this guide if they offer services across those categories. While this makes the guide lengthier, we aim to focus on family use of the guide rather than efficiency in creating/updating the resources.

In order to help you with navigating this resource guide, we have created a glossary in the following pages that describes the types of services you will find in each of the categories. Selecting specific services or providers should be done with care based on your own family needs and values, and we recommend contacting multiple providers to best evaluate your options. The first contact in seeking resources should always be your child's school district or county health department, as there are many options available through their programs before families need to set out on their own to get support. Glossary

In alphabetical order; titles are hyperlinks so if you click on the bold/underlined title it will take you to that section <u>Advocacy & Rights</u>

Organizations that assist individuals and families in understanding their rights, such as education and housing, and accessing information and resources that helps meet family needs. There are also resources included for self-advocacy related to employment (e.g., employment preparation and support).

Case Management & Planning Services

Organizations and resources that can assist with navigating the Medicaid application process, provide support in understanding and accessing resources available through Medicaid, and managing/coordinating healthcare and other services/needs. These services include care coordination organizations (CCOs) that can support families in accessing a variety of programs and funding that are difficult to navigate and access on one's own.

Daycare Support

Resources for local daycare providers; Hours and costs vary, and many providers have waitlists. It may be helpful to contact multiple providers and be added to numerous waitlists for the greatest chance of securing a daycare opening. Families are strongly encouraged to research licensed daycare providers using the online tools from the Office of Children and Family Services (https://ocfs.ny.gov/programs/childcare/looking/).

Food and Resource Programs

This section includes local food pantries, community resource programs (e.g., organizations that provide clothing, housing, infant supplies, technology loans, etc., as well as waivers or grants for medical bills and certain other expenses), and transportation resources.

Home & Community Caregiver Support

Organizations that may have options for short-term (i.e., 1-8 hours), longer-term (i.e., 8-24 hours), and ongoing (e.g., weekly check-ins) respite care or caregiver support that can be provided in-home or in the community. Respite care involves care that is provided to an individual with an illness or disability either in their home, at a center, or out in the community for an agreed-upon duration. The purpose of this type of care is to provide short-term relief for primary caregivers and allow those caregivers to take care of other needs or responsibilities that are often postponed due to prioritizing the care of their dependent with an illness or disability.

Psychological Services

This includes services related to emotional and behavioral health, from evaluation of developmental needs and specific clinical conditions to individual, family, and group therapy as well as support groups and resources.

Social Opportunities and Camps

Resources for local after-school programs and summer camps, as well as organizations that host social events and recreational opportunities.



Glossary Continued in alphabetical order

Specialty Medical Services

Information for providers with specialized training and expertise in the medical field. All providers listed serve youth, but some serve adults as well. Waitlists are often lengthy, so families are encouraged to consider waitlisting with multiple providers unless otherwise advised by their pediatrician. Specialty areas include developmental behavioral pediatrics, neurology, feeding and nutrition, sleep, psychiatry, dental, gastroenterology, allergy, ENT (ear, nose, and throat or otolaryngology), audiology, ophthalmology, and allied health/rehabilitation services (physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy). Families should consult with their child's primary healthcare provider to determine which services might meet their needs and obtain referral support from that provider.

Substance Use/Addiction Supports

Information for local centers and a national resource that can offer a range of services and supports for substance use and addiction, including inpatient and outpatient treatment programs, harm reduction, health home care management, crisis support, and information/resources.

Trauma and Crisis Supports

Contact information for organizations that provide resources and support following a traumatic experience, as well as some that offer crisis support (i.e., via a 24-hour crisis phone or chat line).

Age Groups Served

For the purposes of this guide, we use the following groupings to help families know whether a resource option is appropriate for their child's age. The grade/age categories are approximate matches. We recognize that children may have ungraded IEPs or be progressing at different rates in terms of educational status.

Early Childhood (birth-age 5) Elementary School (grades K-4; ages 5-10) Middle School (grades 5-8; ages 10-14) High School (grades 9-12; ages 14-18) Adulthood (ages 18-21*) Caregiver/Family (18+)

^{*}Some services may be available beyond 21 but since this resource guide is designed for supporting families up through the latest age of legal educational enrollment we are only confirming services through 21 years of age when listed as adult services. Families should inquire on their own if services are available beyond that age when contacting agencies.
