

**Material Type** includes articles, books, journals, images, etc.

The **Title** is the full name of the resource. For articles, it is the title of the *article*, not the name of the journal that contains the article.

The **Creator** lists the author(s), editor(s), or organizational author(s).

In the case of journal articles, the **Is Part Of** field identifies the name of the journal.

**Download PDF** provides one-click access to the resource or to a page with the resource.

**Available Online** jumps to the View Online section which lists all the available databases.

**View Issue Contents** lets you browse the journal's contents by displaying other issues and articles in that journal.

**Report a broken link** is a form where you can submit an issue to the E-Resources Troubleshooting Team.

**Check holdings** previews the location of the physical/print items that the Libraries owns. The link jumps to the Find in Library section.

**View Online** lists the online sources that are available through the Libraries. Oftentimes there is more than one link available.

This is the name of the database where the resource can be found.

**Available from** indicates the publication dates to which the Libraries has access. Sometimes an until date will be listed. There may also be announcements and additional access information.

**Find in Library** displays the location of physical/print versions of the resource.

The name of the location where the resource is being held.

The availability of the physical resource and its precise location or call number.

The **Holdings** field indicates the available date range of the physical resource.
